There are around 750,000 migrant workers in Singapore, and we are in touch with group sizes ranging from 10 workers to 10,000 workers per location and everything in between. There are many ways that corporate groups or companies can help - we have some ongoing, structured programs - but we are always open to a conversation if you would like to discuss a specific way in which you want to help. Listed below are a few current options but this is not an exhaustive list, we do a lot more on an ongoing basis.

Weekday Options



Take a look behind the scenes of what goes on at <u>inspIRRe</u> in a four-hour shift. As a manager volunteer, you will assist in daily chores such as sorting through donations to ensure that they are in good condition, restocking, managing and assisting walk-in donors as well as the unique opportunity of engaging workers.

Timeslots available are either 10.30am or 2pm on weekdays. Weekend options are dependent on manpower availability. In order to ensure a pleasant experience for the team, insplRRe can host up to 20 pax maximum.

Companies are strongly encouraged to provide items for restocking the store. This can be done via an internal donation drive or ordering items to be delivered to insplRRe.

We hope the experience will give further insight on the efforts that our team of dedicated volunteers put in for every shift and gain more appreciation for our wonderful team.


Donation Drive

Shopping for Migrant Workers

With their limited salaries and rising costs of living due to inflation, many migrant workers often struggle with making ends meet. We hope to alleviate the struggle as well as educate volunteers on what migrant workers really need through a shopping exercise that curates a list of needful items. After shopping at the mall, volunteers will be directed to a specific worksite or to distribute freely to road workers. This experience is expected to take half a day.
