
We are delighted to hear from you!

There are around 750,000 migrant workers in Singapore, and we are in touch with group sizes ranging from 10 workers to 10,000 workers per location and everything in between.

There are many ways that corporate groups or companies can help – we have some ongoing, structured programs – but we are always open to a conversation if you would like to discuss a specific way in which you want to help. Listed below are a few current options but this is not an exhaustive list, we do a lot more on an ongoing basis.

Weekday Options





Join us for a 2-3 hour shift to experience the meaningful work that happens daily at inspIRRe. As a volunteer, you'll help sort and restock donations, assist walk-in donors, and engage with migrant workers who visit our store. It's a chance to support our mission while gaining insight into the needs of the community we serve.

Sessions are available on weekdays (except Wednesdays) at either 10:30 AM or 2:00 PM. Weekend slots may be arranged depending on staff availability. Each session can host up to 20 participants.

We encourage companies to contribute \$100 per participant, either through in-kind donations of brand-new items or monetary contributions that will go toward purchasing essentials for the store.

This experience offers a closer look at the dedication behind each shift and helps foster a deeper appreciation for our volunteers and the migrant workers we support.





Migrant workers often face financial strain, with limited wages and rising living costs making it difficult to afford everyday essentials. This CSR activity offers your team a chance to make a real difference—while engaging in meaningful team bonding.

Corporate volunteers will shop together at a mall using a curated wishlist of essential items tailored to the actual needs of migrant workers. Items such as toiletries, snacks, and personal care products go a long way in supporting their well-being.

After shopping, teams will deliver the items to an assigned dormitory or surprise road or construction workers at their worksites—creating a memorable and rewarding experience.

This half-day activity is fully self-run. All costs will be borne by the corporate, and IRR staff or volunteers will not be present. Remote guidance can be provided if needed.

Weekend Options





Makan with Migrant Workers is an initiative by IRR that fosters meaningful connection between the community and migrant workers through a shared meal.

To foster deeper engagement, we recommend a l volunteer to 5 workers ratio. Meals can be hosted at a dormitory (subject to their approval), restaurant, or your own space, with group size adjusted based on venue capacity. Please provide Halal and vegetarian options to respect dietary needs.

IRR will help broadcast the opportunity and secure worker sign-ups. All event planning, coordination, and costs (e.g. catering, logistics) will be managed and covered by the corporate host.

Sharing a meal is a simple way to build understanding —and a moment that leaves a lasting impact for all involved.



Hosting a workshop is a meaningful way to equip migrant workers with practical skills that can enhance their lives. Our most requested topics include Microsoft Excel, Al, AutoCAD, and other digital literacy courses.

Workshops can be held at our dedicated space at Sembawang Recreation Centre. Other impactful topics include yoga, first aid, financial literacy, and more. These sessions not only provide valuable knowledge but also help foster a sense of community and support.

Looking for something more informal? You can also choose to host a one-day sports day, offering workers a fun and engaging break from their daily routines.

Your involvement can create a lasting impact in the lives of those we serve.



If you would like to treat our migrant brothers to a special outing—whether it's a movie, concert, a trip to Universal Studios, or another enjoyable event—we would be thrilled to help facilitate this experience! We kindly ask that you arrange transportation, secure tickets, and, of course, don't forget the popcorn or snacks!

Once those details are in place, we will handle all the coordination to ensure that the workers can sign up for the experience easily. Your thoughtful gesture will undoubtedly foster team spirit and create lasting memories for everyone involved!
