We are delighted to hear from you!

There are around 750,000 migrant workers in Singapore, and we are in touch with group sizes ranging from 10 workers to 10,000 workers per location and everything in between.

There are many ways that corporate groups or companies can help – we have some ongoing, structured programs – but we are always open to a conversation if you would like to discuss a specific way in which you want to help. Listed below are a few current options but this is not an exhaustive list, we do a lot more on an ongoing basis.

Weekday Options






Carepacking & Distribution

Corporates can organise a care-packing session at inspiRRre (up to 20 pax) or at their own venue. A minimum of 100 care packs is recommended, with a value of at least \$10 each. IRR can assist with bulk ordering of care pack contents from our usual vendors.

For worksites, IRR can coordinate a brief 10-minute lunch-hour distribution or arrange a drop-off. For dorms and recreation centres, Fridays after 5 PM are recommended, with a 30–45 minute distribution; other timings or durations may not be possible.

Most sites allow 5–10 volunteers on-site; larger groups can be split across multiple locations. Locations cannot be assigned based on preference, and all sessions are subject to availability.

This is a half-day, self-run activity. All costs are borne by the corporate, and IRR staff or volunteers will not be present, though remote guidance can be provided if needed.



Meal Sponsorship & Distribution

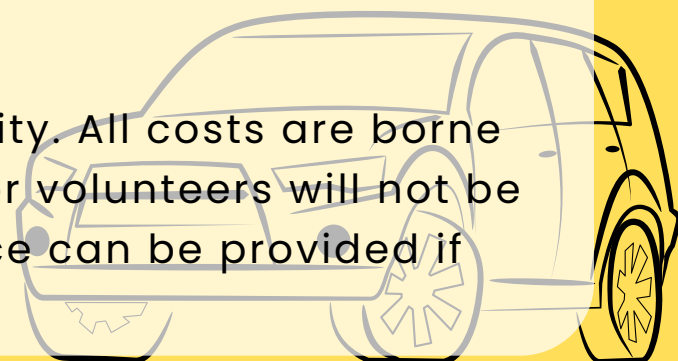
Corporate volunteers can sponsor lunch or dinner meals (e.g. bento boxes, burgers, pizzas), with a recommended minimum of 100 meals.

For worksites, IRR can coordinate a brief 10-minute lunch-hour distribution or arrange a drop-off. For dorms and recreation centres, Fridays after 5 PM are recommended, with a 30–45 minute distribution; other timings or durations may not be possible.

Most sites allow 5–10 volunteers on-site; larger groups can be split across multiple locations. Locations cannot be assigned based on preference, and all sessions are subject to availability.

Sit-down meal sessions are not available on weekdays. If preferred, refer to the Makan with Migrant Workers initiative under the Weekend Options section of this brochure.

This is a half-day, self-run activity. All costs are borne by the corporate, and IRR staff or volunteers will not be present, though remote guidance can be provided if needed.





Manager for a Day

Join us for a 1–2 hour shift and experience the meaningful work that happens daily at inspIRRe. As a volunteer, you'll help sort and restock donations and prepare the store for the weekend, when workers visit. This is a chance to support our mission while gaining insight into the needs of the community we serve. Please note that there is **no direct engagement with migrant workers** for this activity.

Sessions are available on weekdays (except Wednesdays) at 10:30 AM or 2:00 PM. Weekend slots (4 participants max) may be arranged depending on staff availability. Each weekday session can host up to 20 participants.

Companies are required to contribute \$100 per participant, either through in-kind donations of **brand-new** items or monetary contributions to purchase essential items for the store.

This experience provides a closer look at the dedication behind each shift and fosters a deeper appreciation for our volunteers and the migrant workers we support.





Donation Drive

Corporates can choose to organise a donation drive or fundraiser at your own office to collect essential items for migrant workers. This activity will be conducted independently, with no IRR staff or volunteers present.

All collected items will need to be delivered by your team to inspiRRre, our free store for migrant workers. These items will be used to restock the store, and migrant workers will visit on weekends to collect items during our free shopping sessions.

Makan with Migrant Workers

Makan with Migrant Workers is an initiative by IRR that fosters meaningful connection between the community and migrant workers through a shared meal.

To foster deeper engagement, we recommend a 1 volunteer to 5 workers ratio. Meals can be hosted at a dormitory (subject to their approval), restaurant, or your own space, with group size adjusted based on venue capacity. Please provide Halal and vegetarian options to respect dietary needs.

IRR will help broadcast the opportunity and secure worker sign-ups. All event planning, coordination, and costs (e.g. catering, logistics) will be managed and covered by the corporate host.

Sharing a meal is a simple way to build understanding –and a moment that leaves a lasting impact for all involved.






Workshops & Sports Activities

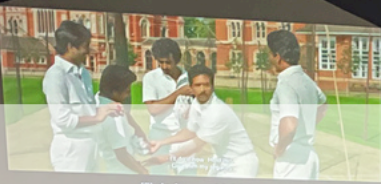
Hosting a workshop is a meaningful way to equip migrant workers with practical skills that enhance their daily lives. Popular topics include digital skills such as Microsoft Excel, AI, AutoCAD, Canva, video editing, and photography, as well as health and wellness sessions like yoga and first aid. Beyond learning, these workshops also foster connection, build confidence, and cultivate a strong sense of community.

For a more informal option, corporates can also host a one-day sports tournament or cycling event, giving workers a fun and refreshing break from their daily routines.

These activities can be held at any of the Recreation Centres for Migrant Workers booked through IRR.

Your involvement can create a lasting impact in the lives of those we serve.

Chinese New Year: Join us for our annual Chinese New Year Bazaar and Donation Drive, where you can spring clean by donating gently used items to support our hardworking migrant brothers and spread festive joy.

Hari Raya Haji: The much-celebrated annual bazaar returns, featuring local favorites like roti prata, curry puffs, and ice cream, while workers receive gifts and enjoy a range of fun, meaningful activities.

Deepavali: There are more than 1 million workers in Singapore and our goal is to send samosas and pizzas to as many workers as we can.

Christmas: Let us come together to wrap presents and distribute brand new presents to as many workers as we can.

More details on each activity will be shared 1–2 months before the respective festive season.

Guidelines for CSR Activities with IRR

Please note that CSR activities with IRR **will proceed only if** the corporate agrees to the following:

- For any activities involving participation of migrant workers, the migrant workers will be recruited from IRR's channels and network of workers.
- For all external events, volunteers from IRR will only be requested if there are sufficient tasks for them to participate in. Volunteer availability cannot be guaranteed, and the corporate should ensure there is adequate manpower to run the activity independently. Remote support from IRR can be provided if required.
- Our beneficiaries are able to communicate in basic English, and translation support has not been required for any previous events. Should you wish to have translation assistance, please arrange for it independently.
- Funds donated to IRR will be used solely for expenses directly related to our beneficiaries and/or our charity.
- Any payments that IRR needs to make on behalf of the corporate will only be processed to Singapore bank accounts. IRR does not conduct foreign transactions.
- IRR will not make any physical purchases. Purchases can only be made from online platforms that offer delivery services.
